- With its analysis complete, Tradition pursued a strategy that would leverage its experience advising hundreds of K12 schools, as well as deliver a competitively-solicited and publicly-awarded cooperative contract to achieve the most efficient energy procurement process, available through OMNIA Partners.

- Tradition Energy negotiated a multi-year electricity supply agreement on behalf of the CREC Magnet Schools that *locked down their costs and reduced annual spend by 16%, saving the schools close to \$1 million over the term.*
